Dear Parents,

In September we will have children in school who have nut allergies. Any exposure to peanuts/nuts may cause a life-threatening allergic reaction that requires emergency medical treatment. To reduce the chance of this occurring, we are asking that from September no products containing peanuts or nuts are brought into school.

Please be considerate when packing your child's lunch or snack as items such as biscuits and cereal bars, peanut butter and hazelnut chocolate spread in sandwiches, contain nuts. An allergic reaction can be very serious for the children affected and can be brought on by even minimal contact to nuts. If peanuts/nuts have been eaten before coming to school, please be sure that hands and face have been thoroughly washed before entering the school.
