How far in history can you go back?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Practise telling the time on an analogue clock, Yr R to the hour, Yr1 $\frac{1}{4}$ past, $\frac{1}{2}$ past and $\frac{3}{4}$ to and Yr2 every 5 minutes.• Practise paying for items in a shop and checking the change.(Yr1 & Yr2)• Practise different number facts within 10 (Rec & Yr1) and within 20 (Yr2) - See attached number sheet.• Learn to tie your own shoe laces.
