Dear Parents,

As you have probably been informed by your child, the Key Stage 2 children of Hemyock School are starring in the production of 'Robin Hood and the Sherwood Hoodies' at the New Hall Theatre in Tiverton.

The production will be held on Wednesday 28th June 2017, matinee at 1.30pm and evening performance at 7pm. All the cast will be transported to the venue by coach, where they will be supervised by staff all day. Your child will need to **bring a packed lunch for lunchtime**. If you are entitled to receive free school meals, please contact the office to arrange a packed lunch from our kitchen. We will spend tea time at Wilcombe Primary School, where your child can have a hot meal of Sausages and Mash or veggie Sausages and Mash, followed by a dessert of Homemade Cookies. The meal costs £2.40 paid to the office in advance or you may wish to send your child with a packed tea. Please let us know by completing the reply slip below and return it by Friday 9th June.

All children will need to be collected by their parents after the evening performance at approx. 8.30pm.

Rehearsals will take place at the New Hall Theatre on Monday 26th June. We will travel to the theatre with Redwoods Coaches at 12pm and return to school by 4pm. Children will be able to have a school meal before they go as they will eat at 11.30am.

Our PTFA are selling tickets at £6.50 per seat from the school office (cash or cheque made payable to Hemyock PTFA). Both performances go on sale from Monday 12th June at **3pm**. Tickets are limited to 4 tickets per family and will be sold strictly on a first come first served basis. You will not be able to reserve any tickets and they are non-refundable. Each ticket will have the seat number issued on it, which will then be entered into a draw. The draw will be held during the interval. Tea and coffee will be available to purchase for the matinee interval and our PTFA will be running a bar for the evening performance.

We are looking forward to another high quality performance this year. Not all the children will have a leading role, but they all have an important part to play in the performance. Your child will inform you of the role they will be playing and we will send a note home if we require help with their costume. Please would you let the office know if your child is allergic to face paint. Please can you also support your child in learning their lines if they have a speaking/singing part. We hope the children will learn their lines over half term and the songs are now available to practice on our website www.hemyock-primary.devon.sch.uk.
