Re: Homework

Each term, the children will be given a selection of tasks relating to different curriculum areas and the topic being learnt at school. There will be enough tasks to allow the children to complete one each week. There will be an expectation that the children hand in their tasks. Please see the sheet attached. Children will receive house points for completing the tasks and extra points for completing them to a high standard.

The tasks will be sent home at the beginning of each term and will also be uploaded onto the Class page on our website.

Our aim is that the children will have fun selecting the tasks that are appropriate to their interests and linked to their learning in school. It also allows parents to fit learning at home into different home routines, taking away the demands of homework being returned on time.

In addition to the task sheet we encourage parents to support their children with the following areas of learning at home:

**Reading** – Children should be encouraged to read daily at home. Children should be bringing home a reading book from their Accelerated Reader book band. The children will complete a reading comprehension quiz at school once they have read the book.

**Spelling/Phonics** – Each week in school your child will be taught a new Phoneme /spelling pattern. This will be recorded in their reading record along with an activity to complete. Encourage your child to practise this pattern in the different ways.

**Maths Calculations** – On the class pages of our website you will find links to Maths websites which will allow your children to practise number activities. In addition to this children in Key stage 2 can access Times Table Rockstars to practise their multiplication and division facts.
