Healthy Snack

We encourage all children to bring in healthy snack for morning break. There is a fruit/vegetable choice available for all children in EYFS and KS1.

Snacks can consist of fresh fruit or vegetables, dried fruit or a snack bar (no added sugar, nuts, sesame or any chocolate or confectionery).

Please be considerate when packing your child's lunch or snack, as an allergic reaction can be very serious for some of the children affected in our school and can be brought on by even minimal contact to nuts.

Medicine forms

If your child needs medicine administered during the school day, please complete a Administration of Medicine form and hand it in to the office with the medicine. We cannot administer medicine without this authorised consent form.

For obvious safety reasons, please do not send your child to school with medicine in their bag.

We can only administer medicine during lunchtime, so please bear this in mind when scheduling doses.

Voluntary one-way system

Thank you for supporting the voluntary one way system of entering via Parklands and exiting through Logan Way. We ask all drivers to be patient with community members and visitors to our village, who may not be aware of our drop off and pick up system.

Please provide a water bottle for your child, we can only allow water in the bottle. Please do not provide squash, fruit juices or fizzy drinks.
